Research Papers (3000-6000 words)

Book Reviews (1000-1500 words)

Opinion Pieces (500-700 words)

Graduate Research (1000-2000 words)

Note: All manuscripts are to be prepared according to the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA), Seventh Edition, including title page, abstract, keywords, in-text citations, pagination, headings, tables, figures, and reference list. Tables and figures should be included as appendices. Title page, references, tables, and figures are not included in the word count.
